Why do you need Traffic Management?

When working on roads or footpaths you need to be compliant with the following organisations.

- New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA) - Code Practise for Temporary Traffic Management (COPTTM). Adopted in 2001.
- Various councils in New Zealand have adopted the NZTA Local Road Supplement (LRS). Dunedin City Council adopted the code in 2007.
- Occupational Safety & Health (OSH) / Department Labour.

Companies and organisations that carry out work on State Highways or Local Roads are required to comply with New Zealand Transport Authority (COPTTM) and the Dunedin City Council adopted version (LRS).

All activities on the road must comply with this code when working within 5m of the road edge or occupying a live lane.

Your organisation is required to have a TMP for your activities and have sufficient traffic management in place as set out in the COPTTM.

Failing to follow these guidelines could result in prosecution if workers or the public are injured, or a fatality occurred while undertaking work or participating in an event.
